IMPORTANT CHANGES at the practice...

Due to the covid pandemic, after a risk assessment we have had to make some changes to how the surgery operates. If you are dropping off a sample or prescription request, there are now drop boxes next to the main door, you do not need to come into the building for this.

When arriving at the surgery you will need to wear your own face covering at all times whilst in the building. You will notice we have on the outer door a **RED/GREEN**; **STOP/GO** system to ensure social distancing is adhered to. If the light is **GREEN** please enter the building and go to reception where there is a sneeze screen in place. If the light is **RED**, please press the intercom buzzer outside and wait for reception to help you. Hand sanitisers are available inside and we encourage patients to use these. The receptionist will ask you to take a designated seat in the waiting area, these seats are limited, so please do not arrive any earlier than your appointment time. Your appointed clinician will escort you to the clinical room wearing full PPE. There is a short video on our Facebook page which you may wish to view.
